SB 307 Resolution of Intent to Impose an Increase in Levies

Be it resolved that as an essential part of its budgeting process, the Swan River School Board of Trustees is authorized by law to impose levies to support its budget. The Swan River School Board of Trustees estimates the following increases/decreases in revenues and mills for the funds noted below for the next school fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, using certified taxable valuations from the current school fiscal year as provided to the district.


Transportation: Estimated change in revenues: \$0 increase. Estimated change in Mills: 0 increase. Estimated impact on a home of \$100,000 is a \$0 increase, and on a home of \$200,000 is a \$0 increase.

Tuition: Estimated change in revenues: \$0 increase. Estimated change in Mills: 0 increase. Estimated impact on a home of \$100,000 is a \$0 increase, and on a home of \$200,000 is a \$0 increase.


Building Reserve: Est. change in revenues: \$1650. Est. increase in Mills: 0.24. Est. increase on a 100K home. 0.32. Est. increase on a \$200K home is \$0.64.

Impacts above are based on current certified taxable valuations from the current school fiscal year. The listed information are estimates. If it becomes evident during the budgeting process that increases/decreases are different or not necessary, then Swan River School Board of Trustees will make the changes accordingly.

Regarding the increase in the building reserve levy referenced above, the following are school facility maintenance projects anticipated to be completed at this time: Safety improvements and building upgrades
